## When can I come to the clinic?

### Routine clinic

There are clinics every day on Monday to Friday where you can have sexual health screening and treatment for all STIs and other genital problems.

There is a choice of appointments and a daily walk-in clinic.

The walk-in clinic runs from 12.15pm until 3.15pm and no appointment is necessary.

Monday to Thursday 8.30am - 6.00pm

Friday 8.30am - 4.00pm

### HIV testing

There is a daily walk-in service for people just wanting an HIV test from 12 noon to 1.30pm.

### Young persons' clinic

Wednesday 3.30pm - 6pm

A walk-in clinic for people aged 18 and under. Sexual health advice, contraception, sexual health screening and treatment for all STIs and other genital problems.

### Please note

- You should allow roughly 90 minutes for your first visit to the clinic
- Men should not pass urine for 2 hours before attending.

### Car travel

#### From the east

M40 Junction 8 or 8a, take the A40 then A420 to Headington Centre and follow signs.

#### From the north

M40 Junction 9, take the A34 then A40 northern ring road, turning off for Marston (B4150), then B4495 towards Headington and follow signs.

#### From the south and west

Approach from the A4142 Eastern ring road and B4495.

**Car parking** – Parking is Pay & Display.

### Park & Ride 600 Thornhill to Churchill

Runs every 20 minutes from Thornhill to the Churchill, via Headington and the Nuffield Orthopaedic Centre.

### Public transport

#### Train

The Churchill is 3 miles from Oxford railway station. Allow 15 minutes by taxi from the station forecourt and 30 minutes by bus **No 5**, changing at Queens Lane to the **No 15**.

#### Bus

City Centre – **No 15** Get off in Girdlestone Road. Runs every 10 minutes on weekdays.

**No 10** Cowley – Hollow Way – The Slade – Girdlestone Road – Roosevelt Drive – Oxford Brookes – John Radcliffe Hospital. Runs every 30 minutes. Get off in Girdlestone Road or Roosevelt Drive.

**No 2/7A** Kidlington and Summertown to the City. Change to **No 15** at High Street (Queens Lane).

**Nos 2, 7A** from Barton, **22** from Risinghurst, **280** from Aylesbury, Thame and Wheatley. These services stop in Headington.

**Nos 4, 22**, from Botley, **400** from Seacourt Park & Ride. Change to **No 15** at High Street (Queens Lane).

## When can I come to the clinic?

### Routine clinic

### Out of clinic hours

## Where is the clinic?

The clinic is in the centre of Banbury at the Orchard Health Centre. Parking in the Health Centre car park is free.

### Car travel

From the M40 – Take the Banbury exit (J11) and follow signs to Banbury. Go straight across at the first and second roundabouts. At the next roundabout (below Tesco's) turn left (signposted Town Centre). You will pass a cemetery on your right. Take the first turn right past the Cemetery into Cope Road.

From Oxford via A423 – Follow signs to Banbury. When you reach the Banbury Cross keep going straight ahead. Continue straight on past the pedestrian crossing (St Mary's Church is on the right). At the next set of traffic lights go straight across and take the next turning left into Cope Road.

### Public transport

Banbury railway station is a short walk from the Castle Quay Shopping Centre and the bus station is next to it. From the shopping centre head to Castle Street and then Southam Road.
